## **BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE**

Catering to the educational needs of the Marginalized sections of Tuni and surrounding villages of East Godavari District, 'The Tandava Sugarcane Growers' and the 'Tuni Commission Merchants Association' with the cooperation of several educational philanthropists took the leading role in the establishment of this college in Tuni. It came into existence on 06-10-1980. It was name as TTSCG & TTCMA Government Degree College and was earlier affiliated to Andhra University, Visakhapatnam and later on to AdiKavi Nannayya University, Rajahmundry. In the initial stage of establishment, it was accommodated in the Merchants Association building in Tuni with two conventional courses namely BA & BCom with strength of 80 students. Science stream was started with BSc (MPC) Course in the year 1998. The College was recognized by the University Grants Commission under section 2(f) and 12(b) on 02-08-1988. Since then the College came to be known as Government Degree College, Tuni in course of time.

The College is spread over sprawling 22 acres and has UG and PG blocks in the present premises. Restructured course in Computer Science in BSc has been started from the year 2000. MSc (Organic Chemistry) has been started from the academic year 2003-04. This College has been Re-accredited by NAAC in 2014 with 'B' Grade. An Internal quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established to facilitate and monitor the academic and administrative aspects of the college. Jawahar Knowledge Center (JKC) Extension Centre was established in 2007 in



the college for imparting employable skills and personality development training to outgoing students. Mana TV lessons telecast through SAPNET and additional teaching supplemented by ICT enabled techniques and aids are available which facilitate learner-centric autonomy.

The College was conferred with Autonomous Status from the Academic Year 2017-18. There are fully established English and Computer Labs and new e-facilities have been established with one Virtual Classroom and three Digital Classrooms to enable effective collaborative teaching and learning. Under the Autonomous status, the College has introduced three new courses: BCom (Computer Applications); BSc (BCCs) & BSc (MCCs) in the year 2017-18. In the year 2018-19, the College introduced a new course, BSc (BZC) in order to cater to demand of the course in this region. In the year 2019-20, the college introduced a new course, BSc(MPC)(EM). This year 2020-21, the College has introduced an Honours Degree in BSc Chemistry, BSc(Voc) Pharmaceutical Chemistry and MCom and MSc (Computer Science) under Post Graduation.

The main mission of the college is to provide quality education at an affordable cost to the under privileged weaker sections of the people of surrounding six mandals.
