Objective of the Programme

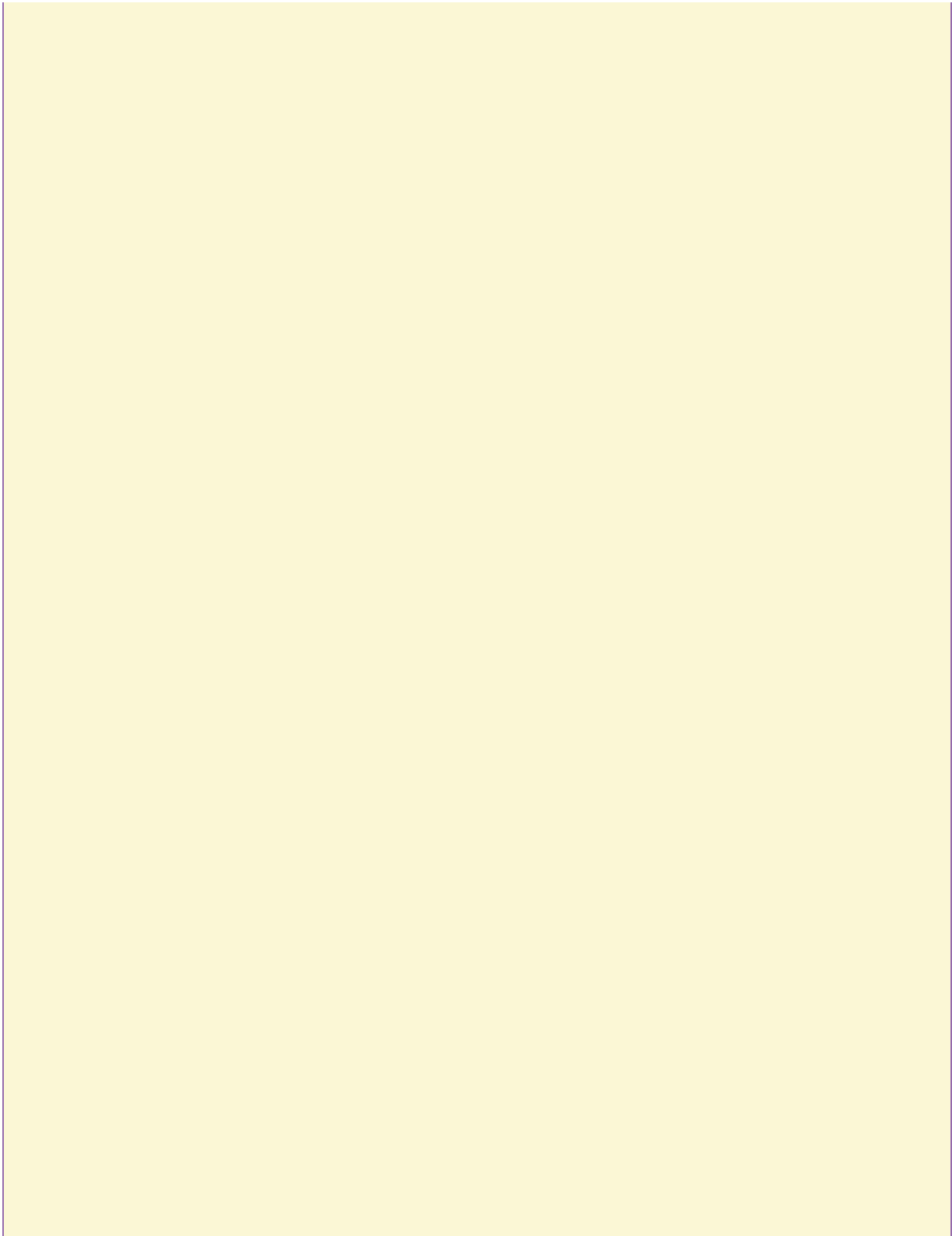
Aim to spread awareness on the importance of the Indian Constitution and to acknowledge the contributions of its architect, Dr B R Ambedkar.
